



RESOLUTION # 10-2016: Acceptance of SWCD Boundary Maps and GIS Shape Files

WHEREAS, Soil and Water Conservation District (SWCD) boundary documentation was created prior to the use of Geographic Information System (GIS) technology; and

WHEREAS, this technology greatly increases the accuracy of mapping and boundary descriptions and minimizes discrepancies in SWCD boundaries; and

WHEREAS, SWCD boundaries were digitized into GIS using historical, written legal descriptions on file with the New Mexico Department of Agriculture; and

WHEREAS, formal acceptance of these GIS based boundary maps will assist SWCDs in their administration and project management;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Valencia Soil and Water Conservation District on this 27th day of June, 2016, that:

In order to ensure an accurate and up to date description of SWCD boundaries and facilitate SWCD operations, the Valencia Soil and Water Conservation District officially adopts the GIS based boundary map supplied by the New Mexico Department of Agriculture as the official boundary. We further acknowledge that the New Mexico Department of Agriculture will draft a concise legal description based on the map.
